



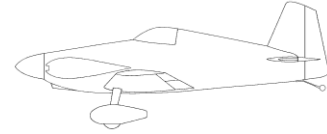

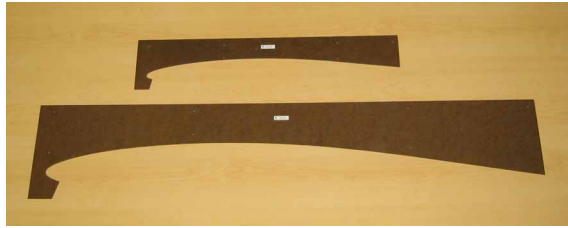
Placing Kit Orders

New at Mustang Aeronautics

Wing Profile Templates



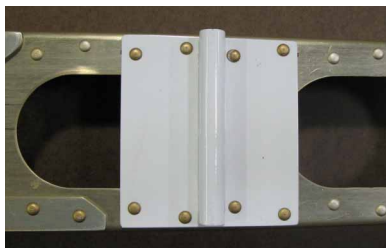
CNC-cut masonite Wing Profile Templates are now supplied with all Midget Mustang and Mustang II Wing kits as well as the Mustang II Center Section kits. These profile boards help the builder to set the proper alignment and twist to the wing. They also locate the trailing edge location. They are available at the following prices:

Part 220.0002 / 230.0008	Wing Root Template	\$25.00
Part 230.0007	Wing Tip Template	\$15.00

Aluminum templates that can be shipped via UPS are also available, but slightly more expensive. The aluminum Wing Root Template can be purchased for \$35 and the Wing Tip Template for \$20.

Wing Tie-Down Brackets

Wing Tie-Down Brackets can be installed on factory assembled Main Wing Spars for \$85.00. This option is available upon request for both the Midget Mustang and Mustang II models that do not incorporate the wet wing. The brackets are made of 4130 steel and powder coated prior to installation. Although these brackets are not currently being supplied with our standard kits, they can be purchased separately by contacting the Mustang Aero factory.



M-II Kit Additions

The following parts are now being supplied with all Mustang II kits, and are also available for purchase:

Part # 260.511 Aileron Pushrod Support Mounting Bracket



CNC-cut, Pre-punched, and formed from .032" 2024-T3 Aluminum. 2 per plane required. These are match drilled to the micarta ball assemblies. Included with Center Section kits. Available for \$9.50 each. (N/A with folding wing option)

Part # 240.409 Control Tunnel Extension



CNC-cut and formed from .032" 2024-T3 aluminum. 1 per plane required. Included with Fuselage kits. Available for \$17.50 each.

**** Please note that many of our parts are now coming with rivet holes in them. For existing airplanes this will be a problem as the holes will not match pre-existing holes. Be sure and specify when ordering if you want un-drilled parts.**

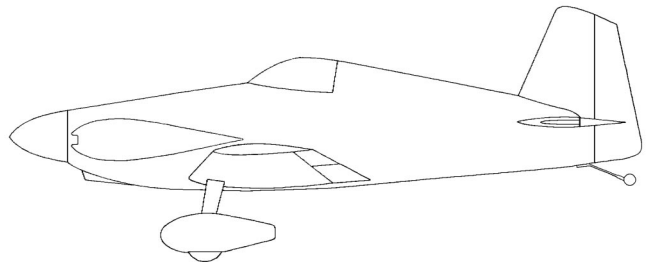
